

RULES OF CONDUCT

In order to maintain an atmosphere conducive to library use, the Flathead County Library Board of Trustees prohibits:

- sleeping in the library
- disturbing library users or staff members
- disturbing the normal functioning of the library
- soliciting of any kind
- tobacco, alcohol use, and illegal drug use
- inappropriate use of library premises or equipment
- food and beverages except in designated areas
- pets, with the exception of service animals assisting the physically impaired or those used in library programs
- vandalism
- disruptive behavior.

Disruptive behavior for all library users is defined as any noisy, threatening or violent action inappropriate to a business setting, i.e. running, fighting, throwing, loud or abusive talking, or any other activities that interfere with library use. Customers will be asked to adapt their behavior to comply with library policy. If a customer fails to do so, appropriate action will be taken, up to and including permanent expulsion from library facilities.
