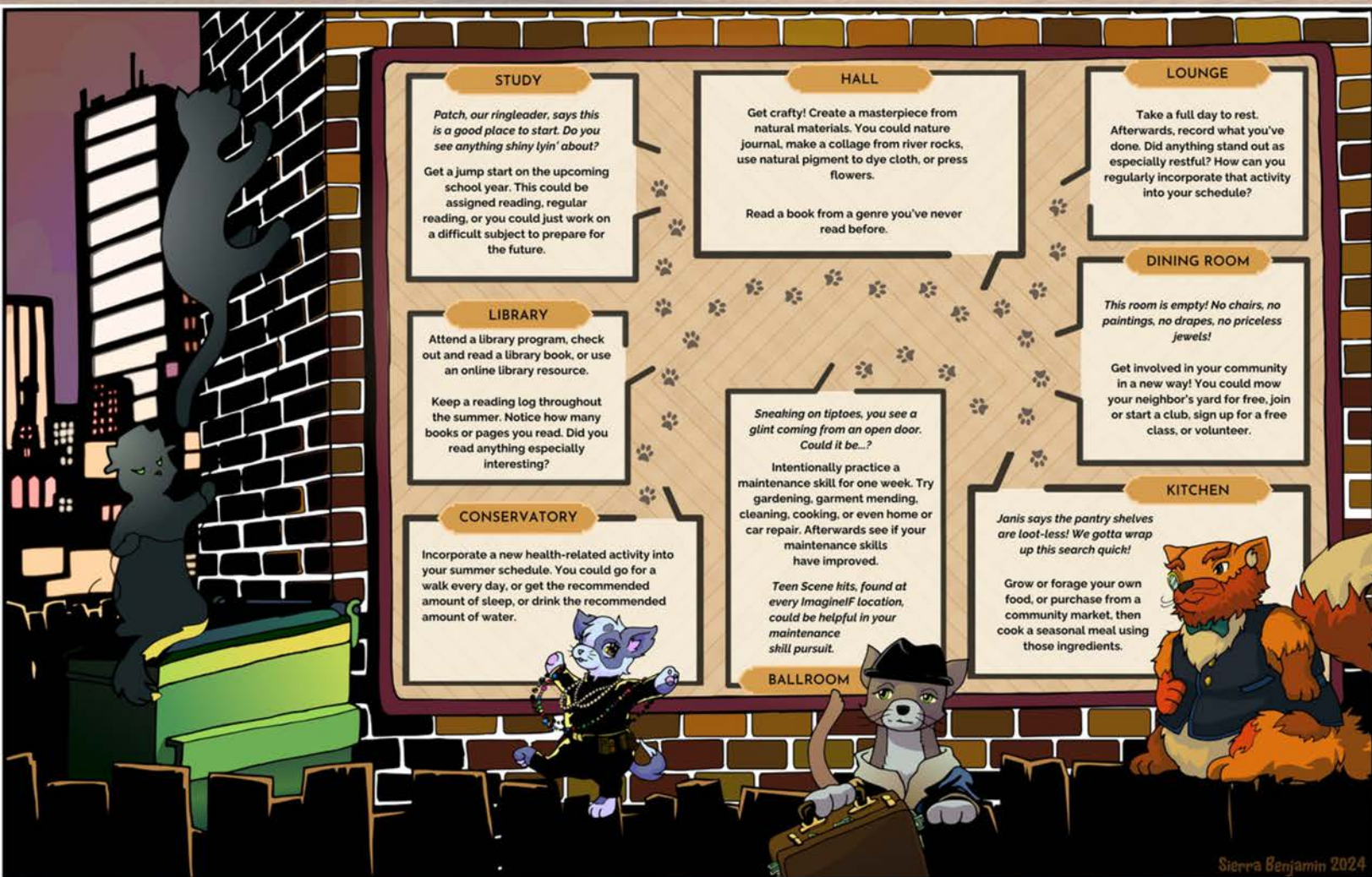

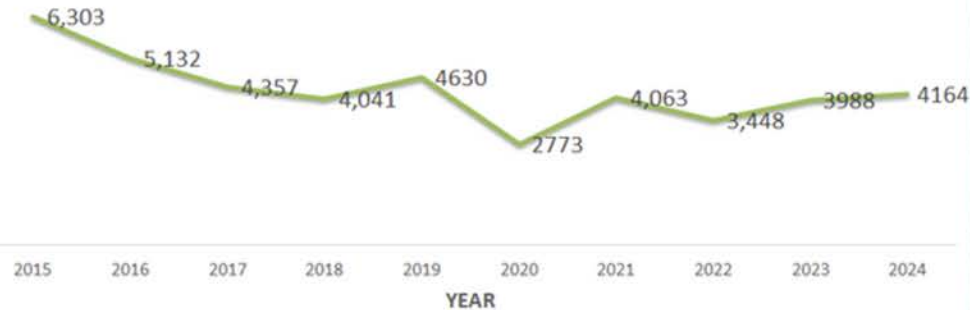
Top Circulating Young Adult Books

Young Adult Materials Circulated

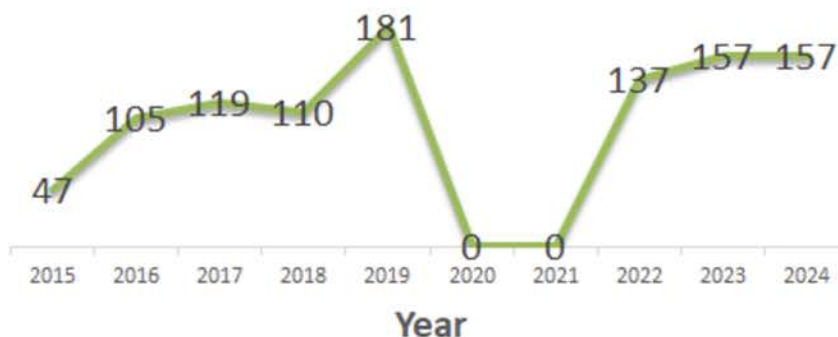
